To connect your fiber optic cable to a router, ensure you have the following: Fiber optic modem (ONT): Most fiber connections require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), provided by your ISP. Compatible router: Verify that your router supports fiber optic input (look for an SFP or WAN port labeled). A fiber optic junction box, also known as a fiber optic distribution box or termination box, is a protective enclosure that facilitates the connection and management of fiber optic cables.
