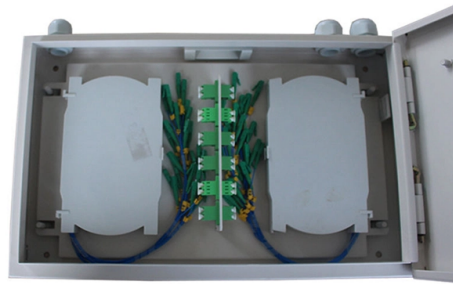

Cable Laying: Lay cables neatly, using ties or straps to separate by voltage and function. Maintain minimum bend radius and leave slack for expansion or adjustments.

Grounding and Bonding: Ensure electrical continuity across metal trays using bonding jumpers every 18 meters. Proper grounding is essential for safety and com...
