Trapezoidal cable trays should be installed using properly spaced supports, secure hangers, and level alignment to ensure safe, durable, and code-compliant cable management. Material Preparation and Inspection Before installation, all cable trays, fittings, and accessories must be inspected for damage and verified against approved material submittals. Trays should be stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of approximately one meter to prevent deformation and protect against moisture and sunlight exposure. Only materials meeting project specifications should be used. Support and Hanger Systems Trapezoidal cable trays are typically supported using trapeze or swing-type hangers, threaded rods, and slotted 'C' channels or 'L' angles. The vertical hangers are fixed with metal plugs or anchors into structural elements, ensuring that the tray bottom is level. Cross members are installed with square washers and hex nuts, allowing for minor horizontal adjustments. Maximum spacing between supports is generally 1.2 meters to prevent sagging, with additional supports provided at bends, branches, and offsets. Alignment and Leveling Elevations for the tray runs should be established using a laser level or transit, referencing a benchmark set by the general contractor. The cross members must be leveled using the bottom set of hex nuts, and the top nuts adjusted to snugly secure the tray while maintaining horizontal alignment. Proper alignment ensures smooth cable pulling and future maintenance access. Fixing the Trays Trapezoidal trays are attached to the cross members using tray clips, which can be installed inside or outside the tray depending on site conditions. Holes in cross members should be slightly larger than the threaded rod diameter (1/16" to 1/8") to allow easy adjustment without damaging threads. All fasteners must be tightened...
