- Enclosure Selection:** Choose an enclosure with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings. For indoor use, NEMA 1 or IP20 is typically sufficient, while higher ratings (e.g., IP66 or NEMA 4) are needed for areas with moisture or dust exposure ().
- Installation Method:** Indoor boxes can be wall-mounted or embedded depending on space and structural considerations. Ensure the mounting surface is stable and capable of supporting the box and its components ().
- Compliance and Safety:** Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards). Ensure proper grounding, secure wiring, correct breaker sizing,...
