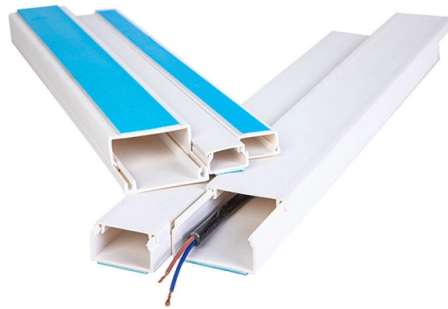

- 6. Labeling and Layout:** Mark each circuit clearly for future maintenance. Route wires neatly, secure with cable ties, and leave space for heat dissipation.
- 7. Testing:** Perform insulation resistance tests and visual inspections before powering on to ensure safety and compliance with standards.
