Wiring and Component Installation

Wire management: Arrange wires neatly in horizontal and vertical runs, maintaining a minimum bending radius of six times the wire diameter. Bundle slack wires and secure connections with spring washers for firm, reliable contact.

Color coding: Follow standard wire colors for three-phase systems (Phase A: Yellow, Phase B: Green, Phase C: Red, Neutral: Light Blue, Protective Earth: Yellow/Green bi-color).

Component verification: Ensure all breakers, fuses, and RCDs/RCBOs are correctly rated and installed. Perform insulation resistance tests and circuit on/off checks before energizing.
