Electrical Grounding Each distribution box and controller must be grounded. In the US, use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard. Connect a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate, then from the mounting plate to the central grounding point. Ensure the total ground resistance between all system parts is less than 0.1 Ohm. For longer tool cables or multiple spindles, additional grounding wires may be required to maintain proper resistance. Use waterproof strain relief bushings for conduit connections to maintain safety and weatherproofing. Securing the Distribution Box Place the junction or distribution box on top of the ground stake. Use the provided screws and gaskets to secure the box to the stake, ensuring a weather...

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
