Connect the neutral wire from the output of the RCCB to the Neutral Link. Wire color: The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red) should meet the standard. Always double-check your connections and follow local wiring standards to stay compliant and safe.
