If the sleeve is longer than 12 inches, the cable should be clamped at the point where it enters the sleeve to meet the securing requirement. Transition fittings: When NM cable enters a sleeve, a transition fitting may be used to clamp the cable at the sleeve entrance. After this point, the cable is considered protected by the sleeve, and additional clamping inside the sleeve is generally not required. Practical Installation Tips Choose the right sleeve material: Use EMT for metallic protection or PVC for non-metallic applications, depending on environmental conditions and code requirements. Ensure proper alignment: The sleeve should be aligned with the knockout or outlet of the distribution box to avoid sharp bends that could damage the cable insulation. Chec...
