Check the switch's power supply: Ensure that the power supply is rated to handle the full PoE load of the switch. If the power supply is underpowered, it may need to be replaced.

Troubleshooting Common Issues in UPOE and POE+ Networks

Network Equipment Resets: Sometimes, simply restarting your PoE-enabled switches can resolve detection issues. This reset can help re-initiate proper negotiations between the switch

Check the PoE port indicator on the PoE switch or PoE injector. If the indicator is not on, you can plug the camera into another port and try using another Ethernet cable.
