Ensure that the total power demand of connected devices does not exceed the switch's capacity to avoid overloading ports or causing power interruptions.

Distance and Cable Limitations Ethernet cables have a maximum recommended length of 100 meters for reliable data transmission. Extending beyond this distance may result in signal degradation or packet loss. For longer distances, specialized equipment like wireless bridges or fiber connections may be required.
