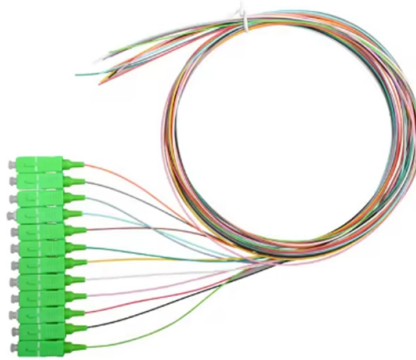

- Attaching Connectors:** Install the appropriate conduit connector onto the prepared conduit end. For PVC, use solvent cement or pipe glue; for metal conduits, tighten set-screws or locknuts.
- Securing to Junction Box:** Insert the conduit into the junction box knockout or opening, ensuring a snug fit. Tighten connectors to maintain mechanical stability and grounding integrity.
- Sealing and Protection:** Use weatherproof or liquid-tight fittings for outdoor or wet locations to prevent moisture ingress.

- Conduit (PVC, EMT, or rigid metal)
- Conduit connectors or PVC fittings
- Hacksaw or conduit cutter
- Reamer or file
- Screwdriver or pliers (for metal fittings)
- Solvent cement or pipe glue (for PVC)
