For small-diameter control cables, 6-12 inch rung spacing is recommended; for large power cables, 9 inches or wider. Cable Management: Maintain proper bending radii for all cables to prevent damage. Ensure cables are neatly laid without excessive drooping between rungs. Ladder trays are designed to support cables, not personnel, so avoid using t...
