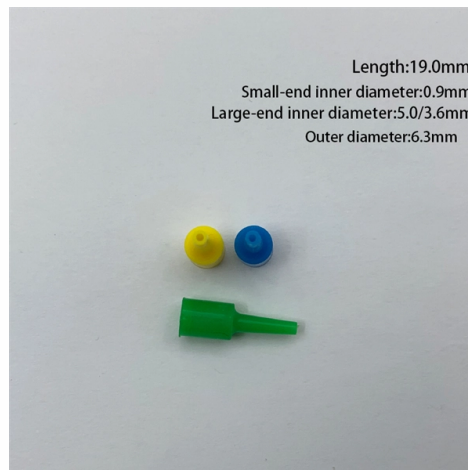

It is typically issued after Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) and is a prerequisite for installation or integration into larger systems, such as data centers or industrial electrical networks.

Key Testing Procedures Level 1 certification generally involves the following critical tests:

- Temperature Rise Testing:** Ensures the box operates safely under full load without exceeding temperature limits, typically conducted at maximum rated current for several hours.
- Insulation Resistance and Dielectric Strength:** Confirms electrical isolation between circuits and from live parts to the enclosure, often tested at 1.5–2 times the rated voltage.
- Short-Circuit Withstand Testing:** Verifies the box can safely handle fault currents without structural failure, with currents ranging from 6kA to over 100kA depending on application.
- Ingress Protection (IP) and Impact Resistance (IK) Testing:** Assesses resistance to dust, water, and mechanical impact, ensuring the enclosure maintains safety functions under environmental stress.

Documentation Requirements A complete Level 1 acceptance process requires a technical file including:

- Detailed assembly drawings, circuit diagrams, and material specifications.
- Component datasheets and certificates for critical parts like busbars, terminals, and breakers.
- Test reports documenting all safety and performance verification.
- Risk assessments and user manuals with installation instructions.
