- Offices and commercial buildings
- Floor or indoor distribution points

Low-voltage distribution cabinets, in contrast, are larger, modular, and serve as the main switch or distribution center of a low-voltage system. They can handle higher currents (up to 6300A or more) and include complex protection, measurement, and control functions. These are typically used in:

- Factories and industrial plants
- Substations
- Large commercial complexes
