Some J-Hooks feature metal bases with plastic components to provide a smooth, burr-free surface and maintain proper bend radius. Many models include snap-lock cable retainers for easy installation without additional ties or straps.
- 3. Aerial Mounting Hardware** This category includes clamps, brackets, suspension mounts, and anchor plates for securing fiber optic cables overhead. These components are designed to anchor cables to poles, walls, or facades, providing stability and protection from mechanical stress. Accessories may include extension hooks, open anchorage hooks, and suspension pulleys for ADSS fiber optic cables, allowing for flexible installation and adjustment.
