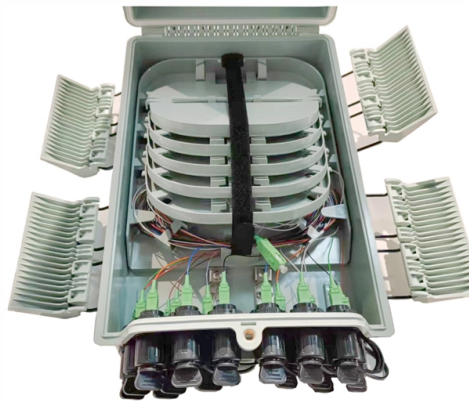


Methods for Proper Layout of Network Cabinets

Patch panels and networking gear: Install patch panels above heavier equipment for organized cabling and easier access.

Power distribution units (PDUs): Mount PDUs vertically at the rear to provide safe and reliable power delivery.

Future-proofing: Leave space for expansion and avoid buying cabinets that are too small.

Cable Management Labeling: Clearly label all cables to simplify maintenance and troubleshooting.

Cable racks and reels: Use 1U or 1SU cable racks for structured routing; optical fibers may require winding reels.

Color coding: Use different colored cables for switches or network segments to reduce confusion.

Separation of power and data cables: Keep them apart to reduce interference and improve safety.

Short, consistent patch cables: Minimize clutter and maintain airflow.
