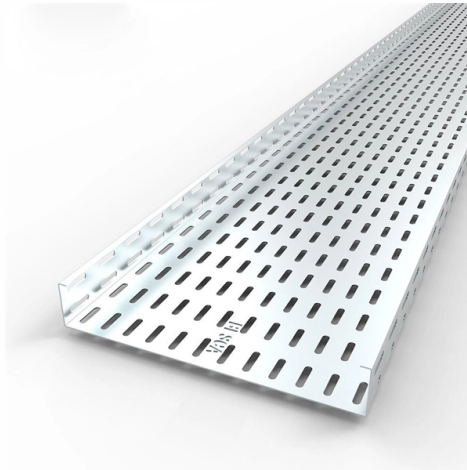


National Standard for 304 Stainless Steel Cable Trays

Cable tray shall be installed according to the latest revision of NEMA VE 2. Stainless Steel: Straight section and fitting side rails and rungs shall be made of AISI Type stainless steel. Transverse members (rungs) or corrugated bottoms shall be welded to the side rails with Type 316. These systems provide an efficient and adaptable solution for managing a wide range of cables, including power cables, control cables, Ethernet, and fiber optic lines.
