Standard Dimensions

Width: Cable tray widths are the primary factor determining cable capacity. Length: Standard tray sections are usually 2 meters or 3 meters long, though custom lengths are available. Modular lengths allow for easier installation and flexibility in routing.

Material Thickness: Tray thickness varies depending on load requirements and material type. For galvanized steel trays, thickness typically starts at 1.5mm for light-duty and can exceed 2.5mm for heavy-duty applications. Thicker trays provide higher structural support and reduce deflection under load.

Tray Types and Specifications

Ladder Tray: Open design with side rails and rungs; ideal for large power cables. NEC specifies that the interior usable width must accommodate the total cable diameters, and cables larger than 4/0 AWG may require separate zones.

Solid Bottom Tray: Provides full support for sensitive or small cables; the sum of cable diameters should not exceed 90% of the tray width.

Perforated Tray: Offers ventilation while supporting medium-sized cables; perforations aid in heat dissipation and reduce weight.
