Containment Systems: For high-density racks, consider rack-level or row-level containment to isolate hot and cold air streams, improving cooling efficiency and reducing energy costs. Top-of-Rack Switch Considerations: Some network switches have side or front air intakes. Ensure that these devices do not exhaust hot air into the cold aisle, which can create thermal conflicts and reduce cooling effectiveness.
