This involves using a dedicated grounding conductor to connect a grounding point on the rack to a nearby grounding busbar or electrode .Bonding: All metallic parts of the rack and equipment installed within it should be bonded together to ensure a low-impedance path for fault currents. This includes connecting all removable panels and doors to the main body of the rack .Compliance with Standards: Follow the ANSI/TIA-942 Standard, which outlines the requirements for telecommunications infrastructure in data centers, including grounding practices .R...
