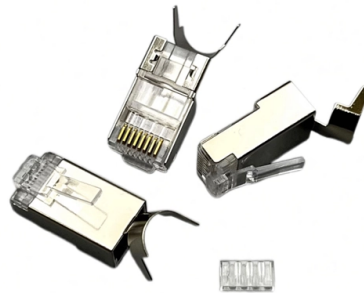

Server rack measurements have been standardized to help unify the design and manufacturing of most server and networking equipment that are designed to be rack-mounted. EIA-310 is a specification for what is often called the “standard rack”. Network racks house servers, switches, and structured cabling in standardized frames. A standard 48-port PoE++ switch now generates 600W+ of heat—equivalent to a small space heater inside your cabinet. Both the IBM® 7014 (Model T00 and Model T42) and the IBM 2101 Model N00 racks conform, but some other racks, including a few from IBM do not.

The minimum vertical rack space per chassis must be two rack units (RUs), equal to 3.5 inches (8.8 cm) . The distance between the chassis air vents and any walls should be 2.5 inches (6.4 cm).
