

Network Rack Switch Grounding Method



Overview

In all situations, grounding practices must comply with Section 250 of the National Electric Code (NEC) requirements or local laws and regulations. In a small SOHO environment where there are, say, 4-5 systems and each system is grounded, is it also necessary to ground the network equipment, that is, the network cable and the switch?

If yes, how it is/can be achieved?

Most of the low-cost switches I have seen, like say this one or this one. Alternatively, you can ground the chassis (this is required if the rack is not grounded) by attaching a customer-supplied grounding cable. Bonding (or grounding) is a system of protective measures, which is implemented to prevent electric shocks when touching metal parts of energy-powered equipment. The whole structure consists of a metal circuit, a protect bus, and a ground wire. For a DC-powered. Grounding lug and disposable ESD strap. Blank covers are installed for the power supply slots on the chassis.
