Containment Barriers: Use modular panels, curtains, or ceiling-supported containment systems to enclose the cold aisle (Profile IT Solutions), .

Airflow Optimization: Ensure servers pull cold air from the cold aisle and exhaust hot air into the hot aisle. Avoid recirculation of hot air into server intakes (Camali Corp), .

Blanking Panels: Fill empty rack spaces with blanking panels to prevent bypass airflow and maintain consistent cooling (Profile IT Solutions), .

Temperature: Maintain a steady server inlet temperature, typically between 18-27°C, to prevent overheating (Matrix NDI), .

Humidity: Keep relative humidity between 40-60% to avoid static buildup or condensation (Matrix NDI), .

Monitoring: Use sensors and monitoring software to track temperature, airflow, and humidity for proactive management (Profile IT Solutions), .
