**Support and Mounting** Supports are critical to prevent sagging. Threaded rods, metal plugs, and 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels are commonly used, with a maximum spacing of 1.2 meters between supports. Additional support is required at bends, branches, and offsets. Structural elements must be verified to carry the additional load, and cutting or drilling into building members should only occur with project approval.

**Installation Guidelines** Cable routing: Maintain adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance. Load considerations: Ensure trays and supports can handle current and future cable loads, including any additional mechanical loads. Safety compliance: Only use mechanically protected cables (PVC or steel-armored) in ladder trays, as non-sheathed conductors are not p...
