Compared to OM3, OM4 has a higher modal bandwidth of 4700 MHz·km, lower attenuation (3.0 dB/km), and supports longer transmission distances (e.g., 100G Ethernet up to 100 meters) (). OM4 fibers are commonly used in data centers, enterprise networks, and telecommunication applications.
