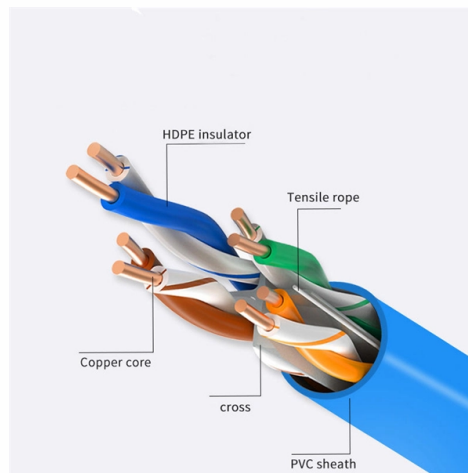


Only connect to the distribution box
