Simply put, optical power is the "brightness" or "intensity" of light. In optical fiber networks, the units of optical power are often expressed in milliwatts (mw) and decibel milliwatts (dbm). The relationship is: $1\text{mw}=0\text{dbm}$, that is to say, $2\text{mw}=3\text{dbm}$, $10 \times \lg \text{mw}$ is the dbm value. Optical power is based on the heating power.
