Secondary Distribution Box: Supplies power to individual buildings or floors, handling three-phase power and larger circuit breakers. Tertiary Distribution Box: Provides the final connection to end-use devices, such as machinery or lighting, often portable or fixed, ensuring individual circuit protection. This hierarchy ensures a complete protection system, following the principle of "one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box" to prevent electrical hazards. Source and Installation Electrical distribution boxes are manufactured by specialized electrical equipment companies and supplied to construction sites through distributors or contractors. They are typically installed near the entry point of utility power or connected to a generator, from where they distribute electricity to different zones of the site.
