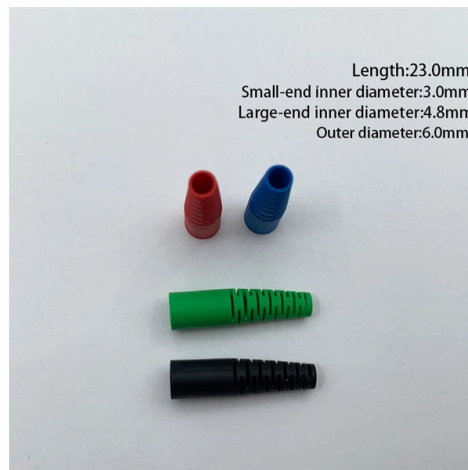


Outdoor distribution box mounting height

 - IEC 60364 and BS 7671:** Recommend residential installation heights from 1 to 1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or disabled users.
- Industrial installations** may have specific width, height, and depth limits for safe access.
- Ground Clearance:** Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to avoid moisture damage, while wall-mounted boxes should maintain sufficient clearance for airflow and maintenance.
- Practical Considerations**
 - Flood-Prone Areas:** Always assess local flood levels and adjust the mounting height accordingly.
 - Cable Management:** Ensure proper drip loops and cable entry points to prevent water from entering the enclosure.
 - Maintenance Access:** Leave enough space around the box for ventilation and future inspections.
 - Safety:** Avoid placing boxes near wet areas or locations prone to accidental impact.
