Installation Best Practices: Use cable trays, conduits, or raceways to protect the cable from sharp bends and mechanical stress indoors. Maintain proper bend radius according to manufacturer specifications to prevent microbending and signal loss. Avoid placing outdoor-only cables in plenum spaces unless they are specifically rated for such use. For vertical riser installations, ensure the cable is supported and does not crush the core.

Performance Implications: Outdoor cables indoors will function electrically, but improper fire-rated jackets or excessive bending can reduce safety and long-term reliability. Hybrid indoor/outdoor cables maintain both signal integrity and compliance with indoor safety standards.
