They reduce installation time, minimize errors, and are available in indoor, outdoor, armored, or hybrid configurations. Patch cables are shorter, flexible cables used to connect devices like switches, transceivers, and patch panels. They are available in duplex or simplex, with lengths from 0.5 meters to over 100 meters.
