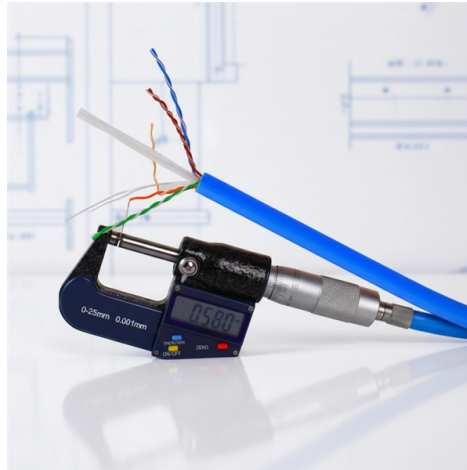


PoE Power Switch Selection

The main standards are: PoE (IEEE 802.3af): Up to 15.4 W per port, suitable for low-power devices like standard IP phones or basic cameras. PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at): Up to 30 W per port, ideal for multi-antenna Wi-Fi access points or PTZ cameras with moderate power needs. PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt Type 3/4): Up to 60–100 W per port, required for high-power devices such as Wi-Fi 7 access points, AI-driven cameras, or PoE lighting. Active PoE switches negotiate power with connected devices, preventing damage, while passive PoE delivers fixed voltage without negotiation, which can be risky if device requirements are unknown. Key Selection Criteria Total Power Budget The total power budget is the maximum combined output across all PoE-enabled ports. Ensure the switch can supply enough power for all connected devices simultaneously. Example: A 24-port PoE+ switch with a 740 W budget can support 24 devices at 30 W each, but cannot power a 40 W device on a single port even if the total budget is sufficient. Per-Port Power Check the maximum power each port can deliver. High-draw devices like PTZ cameras or multi-radio access points may require PoE++ to operate reliably. Device Compatibility Verify that the switch supports the required PoE standard for your devices. Modern enterprise devices often need PoE++ for full functionality. Managed vs. Unmanaged Managed switches allow configuration, monitoring, VLANs, and traffic control, suitable for complex or high-traffic networks. Unmanaged switches are plug-and-play, ideal for small offices or simple deployments. Thermal Design High-power switches generate heat.
