

Power-on sequence for the distribution box

Safety and Preparation

Sequentially close isolating switches on the incoming lines (WL1 first), then close the incoming circuit breaker.

Check busbar condition: Successful closing indicates WB1 and WB2 are in good condition.

Close isolating switches for voltage transformer (VT) circuits and verify supply voltage is normal.

HV Outgoing Circuits

Close all HV outgoing isolating switches, followed by HV outgoing circuit breakers to energize main transformers.

Low-Voltage (LV) Side

Close LV-side knife switch of the main transformer, then the LV circuit breaker.

Verify LV busbar voltage using voltmeters to ensure normal operation.

Close all LV outgoing knife switches, then LV circuit breakers (or fuse-switch disconnectors) to energize all LV outgoing circuits.

Additional Considerations

Never operate isolating switches under load. Ensure proper labeling and neat wiring for maintenance and troubleshooting. Perform insulation resistance and circuit tests before energizing to confirm safe operation. Follow manufacturer-specific connector procedures if using modular or Powersafe distribution boxes, ensuring Earth connections are made first and locked properly.
