- Primary Distribution Box:** Main site-level distribution, connected to the transformer.
- Secondary Distribution Box:** Supplies power to specific buildings, floors, or large equipment.
- Tertiary Distribution Box:** Final connection to individual devices or units, often providing single-phase 220V power.
