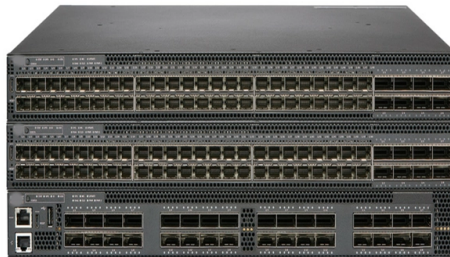

A distribution box, also called a distribution board, panel board, or consumer unit, is the central hub for electricity in a home. It receives power from the utility or transformer and distributes it to various circuits for lighting, appliances, and outlets (). Its primary functions are:

- Power distribution:** Directs electricity to multiple circuits.
- Protection:** Houses devices like circuit breakers, fuses, and RCDs to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical shocks.
- Organization:** Maintains orderly wiring and bus bar connections for safe and efficient operation.

Key Components

- Main Switch / Double Pole MCB (DP):** Acts as the main isolator, allowing the entire home's power to be turned on or off during maintenance or emergencies ().
- Residual Current Device (RCD / RCCB):** Detects imbalances between live and neutral currents, tripping the circuit to prevent electric shocks and fire hazards ().
- Single Pole Circuit Breakers (SP MCBs):** Protect individual circuits by interrupting power during overloads or short circuits ().
- Bus Bars:** Metal strips that distribute incoming power to the breakers and neutral/ground connections ().
- Neutral and Earth Bars:** Provide return paths for current and safe grounding to prevent electrical hazards ().

Wiring Principles

- Incoming supply:** Power enters the distribution box from the utility meter or transformer, typically as a single-phase 230V AC supply in homes ().
- Main switch connection:** The live wire passes through the main DP MCB, which controls the overall power supply.
- RCD integration:** The live and neutral wires are routed through the RCD to monitor leakage currents.
- Circuit distribution:** Outgoing wires from SP MCBs connect to individual circuits, such as lig...
