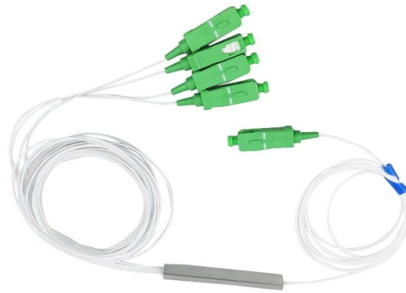


Rate limiting of core switch ports



Overview

Rate-Limiting for all traffic provides a method for limiting the amount of bandwidth a user or device may utilize inbound on a switch port. This effectively sets an inbound usage level on a given port, and is a tool for enforcing maximum service level commitments granted to.
