Cable Sizing and Ampacity Cables must be sized according to the maximum anticipated load and the ampacity of the conductors. Copper, copper-clad aluminum, or aluminum conductors should follow the ampacity tables in NEC Article 310, ensuring that the cable can safely carry the expected current without overheating . Each circuit should have its own protection device, such as a breaker or fuse, to prevent overcurrent damage . Grounding and Bonding All metallic parts of the distribution box, including covers, must be properly grounded. A grounding electrode system should be installed to minimize voltage differences and ensure safety for personnel and equipment . Conductors and grounding electrodes must be bonded together to maintain a continuous path to earth. Cable Entry and Management Distribution boxes should have designated entry points for cables, often with DIN rails or terminal blocks to organize wiring neatly . Cables should be routed to avoid sharp bends, excessive tension, or contact with energized parts. Unused openings must be closed to prevent dust, moisture, or accidental contact . Complan...
