Secure trays with bolts, tightening all connections to prevent movement. Maintain proper spacing and fill to avoid overloading and ensure full current-carrying capacity.
- 5. Grounding and Bonding** Attach a grounding wire to the tray and connect to the building's grounding system. For long runs, install earthing connections between tray sections to maintain electrical continuity and prevent hazards.
