The outer jacket is typically flame-retardant for indoor plenum use or abrasion-resistant for outside plant deployments.

**Access and Identification:** Ribbons are finger-peelable with readily identifiable ribbon IDs and fiber colors, facilitating fast splicing and termination. Some models feature FastAccess® jackets to reduce access time and minimize fiber damage during installation.
