Square rack holes are the most common rack holes in the market today. The standard square sizes are 3/8" by 3/8" varying from 1. This guide dives into the practical aspects of server rack design, including the types of screws, rails, and enclosures. Before installing system components, locate the hole pattern in the rack rails to allow adequate Unit height (U) of vertical space. Rack cabinets that meet EIA-310 standards have an alternating pattern of three holes per rack unit. For the front and back vertical rails, the center-to-center hole. Location of square holes for network cabinet installation

Install two clip nuts on each side in the appropriate square holes for front cabinet rails. Center the panel vertically to prevent intrusion into adjacent rack space, and then tighten the screws.

Rack Hole Size Differences: Square hole vs Round vs Threaded -

Server racks can have either square, threaded or circle holes. Square holes require cagenuts, threaded holes can accept screws directly, circle holes need an adapter.

Network cabinet design considerations

A square-hole pattern that uses captive cage nuts for mounting components has several advantages. For instance, sometimes the fixed-hole patterns on the server and cabinet rail do not line up perfectly.
