Rack Types and Materials

- Materials:** Aluminum racks are lightweight and suitable for cable management only, while steel racks are recommended for mounting active equipment.
- Mounting and Compatibility**
 - Standard Mounting:** Most racks use 19" EIA mounting rails with universal 3/8" square holes for cage nuts, OEM slides, and rails.
 - Modular Design:** Hinged covers, snap latches, and quarter-turn connectors allow flexible installation and easy access for maintenance.
 - Integration:** Vertical and horizontal managers can be integrated into 2-post or 4-post racks, with options for top cable trays and side-mounted cable ducts.
- Cable Routing and Capacity**
 - Vertical Managers:** Include individual rack unit fingers or spools to route patch cords and fiber, providing slack storage and bend radius protection.
 - Horizontal Managers:** Feature rings, fingers, or cable tie bars to organize cables across rack units.
- Capacity:** High-density racks can support hundreds of Category 6 patch cords at partial fill, with recommended fill percentages to prevent overcrowding.
- Additional Features**
 - Accessibility:** Dual hinged doors, removable covers, and toolless mounting facilitate moves, adds, and changes.
 - Environmental Considerations:** Some systems, like Roxtec, are designed for marine...
