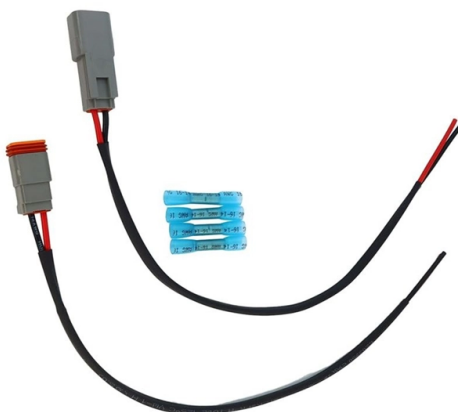


Switch 10G optical port supports optical module

Compatibility Overview SFP+ ports are physically compatible with SFP modules, meaning a 1G SFP can usually be inserted into a 10G SFP+ slot. Auto-negotiation limitations: Fiber SFP and SFP+ modules do not support auto-negotiation, so both ends of the link must be compatible and manually configured if necessary. Practical Considerations Using a 1G SFP in a 10G SFP+ port is economically efficient if the link only requires 1G speed, as using a 10G module would not increase performance. Ensure the switch supports the specific SFP module. Some vendors restrict which SFPs are supported in SFP+ ports, so using third-party modules may require verification. For copper-based SFP modules (10/100/1000BASE-T), auto-negotiation is supported, but for fiber optics, manual configuration may be required. Summary You can generally use a 1G SFP module in a 10G SFP+ port, but it will run at 1G speed. Always verify switch model compatibility, fiber type, wavelength, and vendor restrictions to ensure stable operation. If the switch does not support 1G fallback, the module may not function at all.
