Installation Recommendations Position the panel behind a door swing or in an out-of-the-way area to minimize disruption. Ensure the panel is mounted at a height where the highest breaker handle is no more than 6'7" and at least 4 feet off the ground for compliance. Maintain a clean, dry, and secure location to prevent physical damage and ensure proper function. Avoid placing the panel near furniture or storage that could obstruct access in an emergency.
