Common issues include: Incorrect IP settings (static vs. dynamic IP) MAC address mismatches NAT or gateway misconfigurations Even if your settings appear correct, try temporarily setting the router to auto-detect or consult your ISP to confirm the required configuration.

Step 4: Test Signal and Hardware Use an optical power meter or OTDR to measure signal strength; values outside the normal range (-15dBm to -30dBm) indicate a problem. Check indicator lights on the ONT and router; a "LOS" (Loss of Signal) LED signals connectivity issues. Swap transceivers or routers with known-good units if available to isolate hardware faults.
