Overview

Red/yellow alert: Steady red = serious fault (stop high – power use); blinking red = minor fault (fix soon); steady yellow = low voltage (avoid high – power); blinking yellow = temporary issue (wait or contact if lasting). As far as I can tell, all the breakers in my apartment's panel are showing as tripped (red 'button' visible), and yet everything has power. It is no longer heating up when I turn on the hot faucet. If you have removed power from any wires that were hot, you're "safe". You might want to look at all the outlets + fixtures (lights in the ceiling/wall) that are on that breaker to see if you see anything
