- Hardware or configuration problems:** Incorrect router settings or a malfunctioning WAN port can prevent other lights from turning on.

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check connections:** Ensure the fiber cable is securely connected to the router and the ONT (Optical Network Terminal).
- Reboot devices:** Power cycle both the router and the ONT to restore connections.
- Inspect cables and connectors:** Clean fiber connectors and replace any damaged cables.
- Verify LAN connections:** Connect a device directly to the router using a CAT-5e or CAT-6 cable to test LAN functionality.
- Check router settings:** Access the router's web interface to confirm WAN or PON settings are correct.
