Fiber optic connections between servers and switches enable high-speed, low-latency, and scalable network communication, essential for modern data centers and campus networks.

Server-Side Requirements Servers typically do not have built-in optical ports on their motherboards. To connect a server to a fiber optic switch, a PCIe network interface card (NIC) with optical capabilities is required. These NICs support speeds ranging from 1G to 100G, depending on the server's performance needs. The NIC is then connected to an optical module (SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP, or QSFP28) and a fiber patch cord to establish the link with the switch.

Switch-Side Requirements Switches provide various port types for fiber connections, including Gigabit SFP, 10G SFP+, 25G SFP28, 40G QSFP, and 100G QSFP28. These ports support optical modules, DAC (Direct Attach Copper) cables, and AOC (Active Optical Cables), allowing flexible high-speed interconnections between servers and switches. The choice of port and module depends on the required bandwidth and distance.

Fiber Types and Cabling Single-mode fiber (SMF): Supports long-distance, high-bandwidth connections, ideal for inter-building or data center backbone links. Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Suitable for shorter distances within a data center, with types OM1 to OM5 offering varying bandwidth and reach. Fiber cables transmit data using light, providing minimal signal loss, low latency, and immunity to electromagnetic interference, making them ideal for high-performance server-switch connections.
