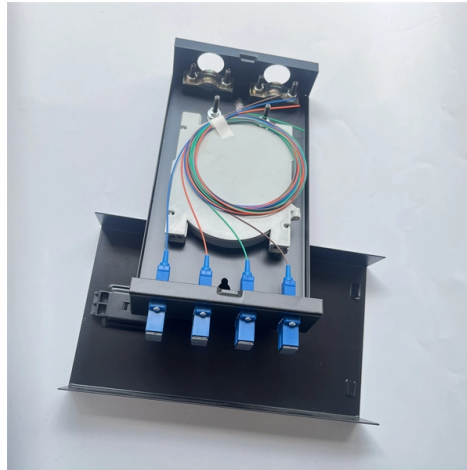


The switch s fiber optic light turns red



Overview

Several reasons can cause the LOS light to blink red: Fiber Optic Cable Damage: A physical cut or bend in the fiber optic cable can disrupt the signal. There are no specific requirements for this document. They show failures in the power-on self-test (POST), port-connectivity problems, and overall switch performance. For a full description of the switch LEDs, see the “LEDs” section on page 1-11. However, when it blinks red or stays solid red, it signifies a Loss of Signal, a problem preventing your router from communicating. If you find that the Optical/Config/PON Light on your Fibre ONT (Optical Network Terminal) box is flashing, has gone off, or has gone red, this indicates there may be an issue with the fibre connection coming into your property. What Can I Do?

First, please check that the optical cable which comes. Status Light: An LED indicating the system's operating status, usually a dual-color (red/green) light. It can also indicate your router is undergoing a firmware update, temporarily losing its link to the internet or local network.
