Circuit ProtectionEach branch circuit must have overcurrent protection, typically via circuit breakers. These protect connected equipment and prevent overloads. Common setups include 15-amp and 20-amp 120V outlets, and 30-amp or 50-amp 240V outlets for larger equipment.

WiringInternal wiring must be sized according to the ampacity of the main feeder and branch circuits. For example, a 50-amp inlet requires at least 6 AWG copper conductors, while a 20-amp branch circuit uses 12 AWG wire.

ReceptaclesThe box should include multiple outlets to accommodate tools and equipment. These may include standard 120V outlets, 240V outlets, or specialized industrial connections depending on the application.

Grounding and BondingProper grounding and bonding are essential for safety. The box should connect to a grounding electrode system to stabilize voltage, protect against lightning, and provide a safe path for fault currents.
